Publish with the Observatory

The Observatory on Borderless Higher Education commissions papers and short news articles from international higher education professionals and doctoral candidates. We welcome proposals on the full range of international higher education topics and we are able to pay a modest fee for reports.

Our global network of members is comprised of about 150 institutions from 24 countries including not-for-profit educational institutions / organisations and for-profit educational institutions, private corporations and government departments / agencies. Notable agencies include Institute of International Education (IIE), International Association of Universities (IAU), EAIE, Boston College (CIHE), Association of Commonwealth Universities OECD (IMHE/CERI) and UNESCO.

PROPOSAL GUIDELINES

All papers and articles must be analytical and not just descriptive. They must be previously unpublished and not under consideration elsewhere. They may, however, be part of a larger work that does have another publisher. Prospective authors who are affiliated with institutions should indicate that they have institutional support for publishing the material.

If accepted for publication, drafts will be subject to peer review and revisions may be required for a final draft.

News Analysis drafts should be between 1,000 – 2,000 words.

For reports the minimum number of words is 5,000 with no upper limit; however most papers published are between 8,000 – 12,000 words, not including bibliography.

SUBMITTING YOUR PROPOSAL

To submit your proposal, please provide the following:

- **Summary Of Your Paper:** Max 150 words on the topic and purpose of your paper or news article.
- **KEYWORDS:** Provide a short list of keywords that highlight the nature of your paper or article.
